Guru Nanak Institute of Pharmaceutical Science and Technology was established in the year 2005 under the aegis of Guru Nanak Education Trust. The institute is situated at Panihati, Sodpur, Kolkata-700114.

The institute obtained statutory affiliation from West Bengal University of Technology (currently known as Maulana Abul Kalam Azad University of Technology), AICTE and Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). This is the first Autonomous pharmacy institute in Eastern India accredited by NAAC & NBA. The institute has consecutively ranked in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) for last four years. In NIRF 2020 we were placed at all India Rank 67 amongst Pharmacy colleges.

The institute runs five post graduate courses in Pharmacy, respectively in Pharmaceutical Chemistry (started from 2011), Pharmacology (started from 2012), Pharmaceutics (started from 2013), Pharmaceutical quality assurance (started from 2020) and Regulatory affairs (started from 2020) with due affiliations from MAKAUT, AICTE and PCI.

Institute effectively integrates cross-cutting issues relevant to gender, environment and sustainability, human values and professional ethics and leads to a strong value-based holistic development of students.

1. Adopted Gender sensitizing policies and free counselling services are provided through a Counselling Cell. Gender sensitization camps are organized in slums and rural areas that include, women's rights, human rights, child rights, gender justice, and gender equality.

2. Environment and Sustainability: Environment awareness camps, seminars, workshops, guest lectures, industry visits, and field excursions are organized. Environment Day, Earth Day, and Water Day are annually celebrated.

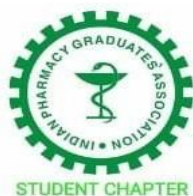
