Guru Nanak Institute of Pharmaceutical Science & Technology conducted surveys and interactive sessions for the stakeholders of the institute to seek feedback on the draft strategy document. It is hoped that the process of obtaining feedback will result in the involvement of relevant stakeholders in building the strategy document and plan for the institute.

The survey was conducted as continuous basis. The feedback survey was done including different stakeholders like students, faculty, employer, alumni and guardian.

Key accomplishments of this process include the following:

- Survey open to all stakeholders students (including exit survey), employer, alumni and parent) to get feed- back on the draft strategy document
- Special Faculty discussion on draft document
- Focus group discussion on time-to-time basis.

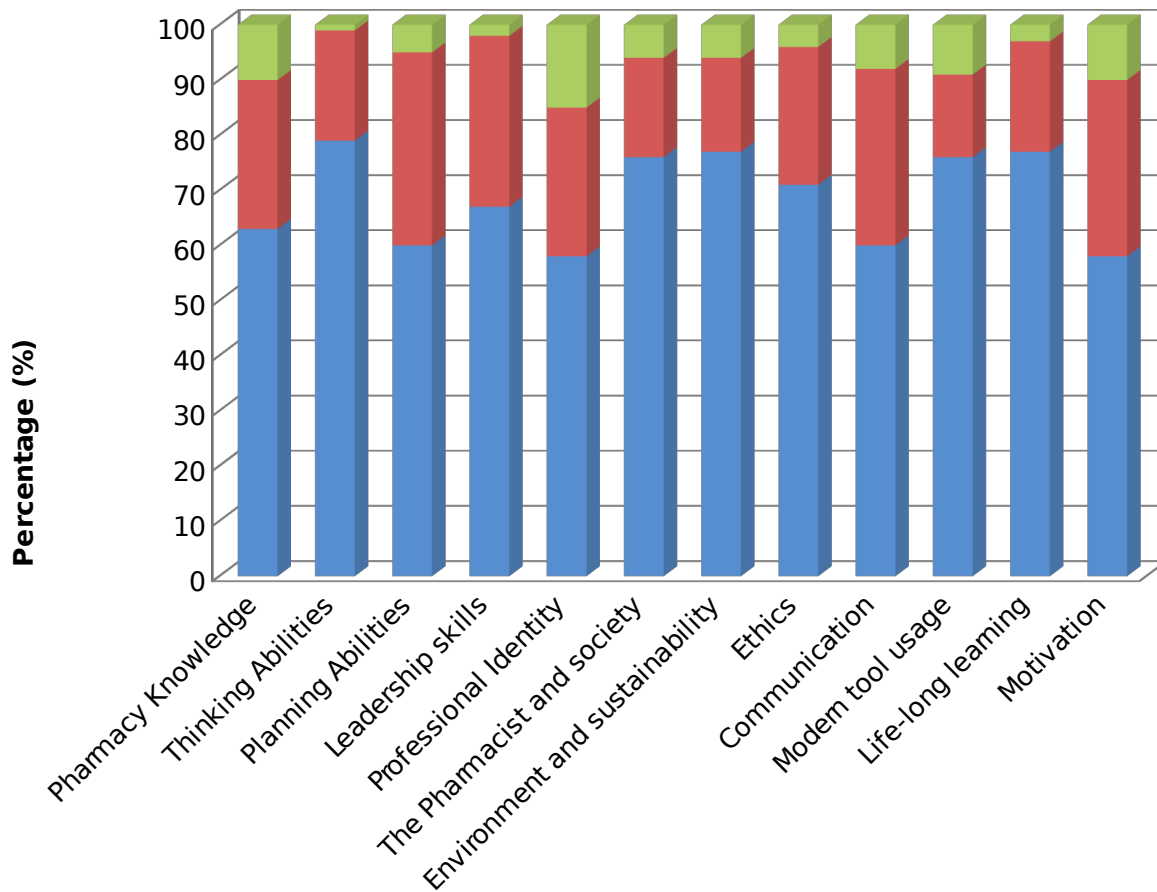
The questionnaires are made for quantitative assessment. The survey included questions related to their association with GNIPST and questions pertaining to the draft strategy document.

- Each of the stakeholders had a different survey tool asking specific questions.
- In student survey, the questionnaire was asked to the currently enrolled under-graduates about their course content, teaching-learning process and onto their Institutional facilities.
- The alumni survey instrument was designed to ask the former students about their opinion related to the survey question and view related to the development of GNIPST.
- Alumni have given their feedback on PEO, PO and onto the general facilities given in college.

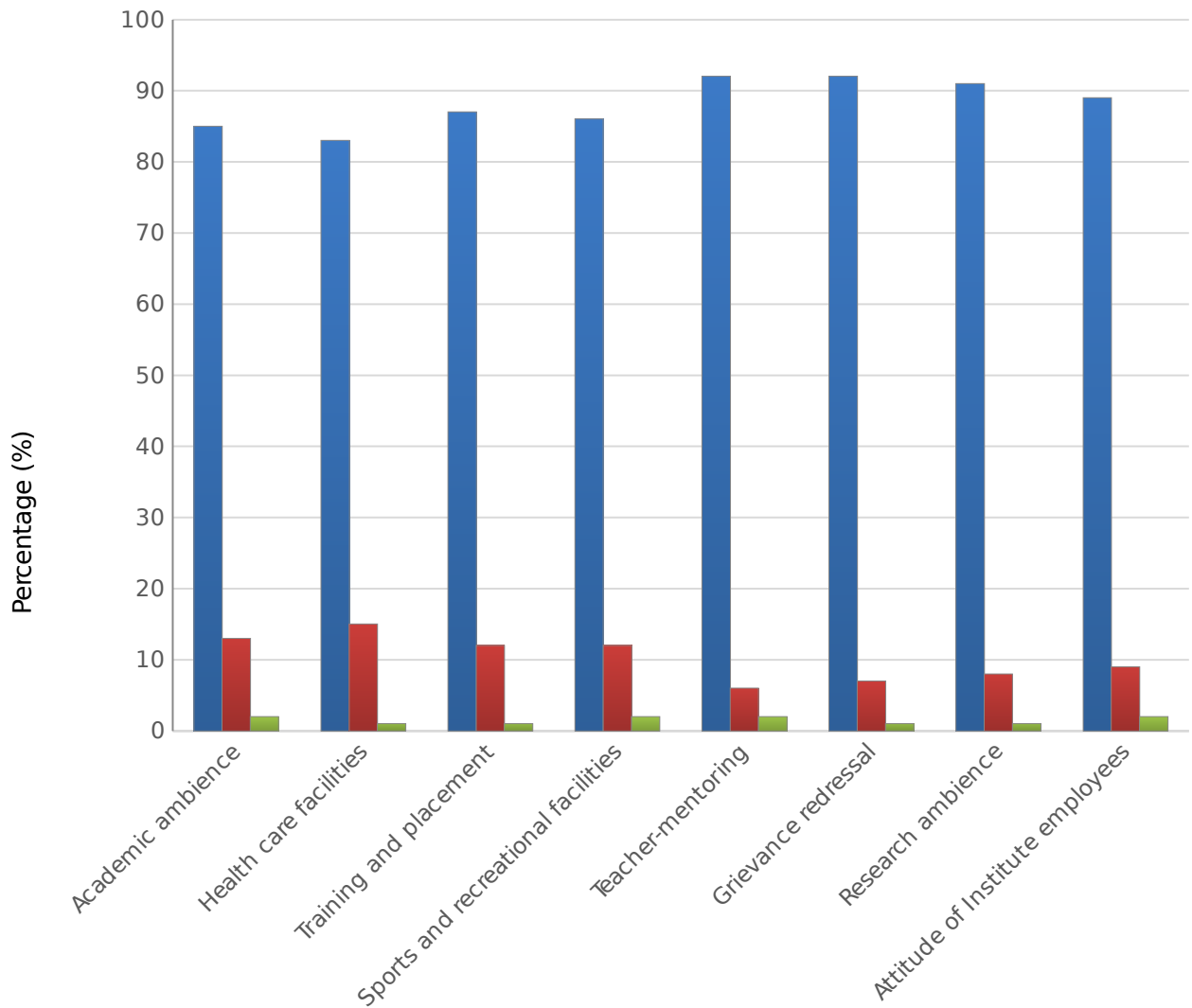
Summary of Exit survey:

As per exit survey (feedback) students are highly satisfied with academic ambiance, training and placement, teacher mentoring, research ambiance. From gross exit survey it is concluded that existing PO statement of the Institute can be more refined. Students also comment on PEO and suggested that PO should be more specific.
